



## Incumbent Pappas well below 50% and underperforming a generic Democrat

- The Congressional Ballot shows Chris Pappas leading by only 4% at 42% Russell Prescott. 46% Pappas. 11% of the electorate remains undecided.
- Prescott leads in Rockingham County (45% -41%).
- After messaging on Prescott, the ballot changes to 51% Prescott, 42% Pappas.
- Messaging on Pappas moves the ballot to a similar position at 50% Prescott, 43% Pappas.
- The tied Generic Congressional Ballot forecasts a highly competitive race.



- Undecided congressional voters prefer a generic Republican 44-30%.
- Undecided congressional voters disapprove of Pappas by a 10% margin.
- On the Gubernatorial Ballot Kelly Avotte is leading with 49% over Joyce Craig at 39%.



## METHODOLOGY

This probabilistic survey was conducted September 26-28, 2024, with 406 likely general election voters. It has a margin of error of ±4.85%. Known registered voters were interviewed via live phones and SMS. This survey was weighted to a likely general election voter universe.
