## NEW POLL: Dan Osborn at 50%, Leads Deb Fischer 50-44

A new poll in the US Senate race that FiveThirtyEight calls the most competitive in the country finds Dan Osborn leading Deb Fischer 50-44%.

This is the first survey that shows Osborn reaching the crucial 50% threshold, five out of the past six surveys in this race show Osborn with a slim lead

**OMAHA** – A <u>new poll</u> of likely Nebraska voters shows Independent Dan Osborn leading incumbent Deb Fischer, 50% to 44%. This is the first poll that shows Osborn reaching the crucial 50% threshold. Five out of the past six surveys in this race show Osborn with a slim lead.

The poll, conducted by SurveyUSA, confirms that the Osborn campaign is surging ahead of Sen. Deb Fischer. In recent weeks, the <u>Cook Political Report</u>, <u>Inside Elections</u>, and <u>Sabato's Crystal Ball</u> all moved the race's rating in Osborn's direction. The <u>FiveThirtyEight</u> polling average finds this race is the closest US Senate contest in the country.

Previously, in the first nonpartisan survey of the race, SurveyUSA found Osborn trailing by one point.

What You Need To Know About New Polling In The Nation's Most Competitive U.S. Senate Race:

- Osborn leads Fischer 50% to 44%.
- Osborn's strength comes despite facing nearly \$5 million / 23,000 GRPs in attack ads. Washington super PACs and dark money groups have been dumping money into this race to defeat Dan, but he keeps growing stronger.

- Sen. Pete Ricketts leads Democrat Preston Love 53% to 37%. Osborn outperforms the partisan environment by 20%.
- Osborn holds a massive 28-point favorability advantage over Fischer. Fischer is underwater at -8 (42% fav/50% unfav), a blaring warning sign for a two-term incumbent. Despite millions in attack ads against him, Osborn remains deeply popular +20 (54% fav/34% unfav). Osborn and Fischer's name ID are virtually even (Osborn 88%/Fischer 91%)

This poll of 563 likely and actual voters was conducted by SurveyUSA on behalf of the Osborn campaign. The margin of error is +/- 4.7%

## Independent Dan Osborn for Senate

Dan Osborn served in the United States Navy, Nebraska Army National Guard, and has punched a clock for 20 years as an industrial mechanic. Now, he's running for the United States Senate as an Independent. Dan isn't taking money from the corporations, and he won't be beholden to the party bosses that control Washington.

Dan began work as an industrial mechanic at the Kellogg's plant in Omaha in 2004. Working long hours, he made a middle-class living for himself, his wife Megan, and his three children. Dan rose to the presidency of his union, BCTGM 50G. He led the successful 2021 Kellogg's strike in Omaha, preserving hundreds of middle-class jobs.

He lives in Omaha with his wife and children.
